



Featured Beer

1903 Craftsman Prohibition Lager – Pasadena, CA

American Craft Lager. What lager is supposed to be, crisp and light, but with some flavor. Roasted grain notes with a nice hop presence.
5.4% abv.

Blanche de Chambly – Unibroue, Chambly, Québec

Not all wheat beers are Hefeweizen. This is a Belgian style wheat beer brewed with Curacao orange peel and coriander and a blend of pale barley malt, wheat malt and unmalted wheat.
5% abv.

Heavenly Hefeweizen – Craftsman Brewing Company, Pasadena, CA

A true quintessential Bavarian style wheat beer. Banana and cloves!
No lemon!
6.2% abv.

Craftsman IPA – Pasadena, CA

An India Pale Ale with nuance that doesn't smack you over the head like some American IPA's. This is a very well balanced beer with sweet malt AND a dry and bitter finish. A big fresh pine needle scent with lots of flowery citrus notes.
6.25% abv.

Trois Pistoles – Unibroue, Chambly, Québec

Trois Pistoles (Three Coins) is a strong dark Belgian style ale is named after a small village in the region of Les Basquesin Québec. Its cocoa and fruit notes make it an ideal dessert companion to semi-sweet and dark artisan chocolates.
9.0% abv.

Quelque Chose – Unibroue, Chambly Québec

Quelque Chose means "something" in French and that's exactly what this beer is. Cherries are steeped in this winter seasonal ale for months. Notes of cinnamon and honey, cloves and vanilla are prevalent. We are serving this beer warm or mulled! Who knew beer could be so good?
